2016 Cypress Ranch Cabernet Sauvignon

This Cabernet Sauvignon was carefully selected from Cypress Ranch Vineyard, where high elevation, gently sloping hillsides and a tremendous diurnal shift result in rich, structurally elegant yields. The 2016 growing season was warm and steady – a cooperative spring and warm summer allowed grapes to ripen fully and evenly, allowing us to pick blocks at optimum maturity and complexity. The 2016 vintage offers intense aromatics with outstanding concentration and balance.

2019 Monte Rosso Vineyard Cabernet Sauvignon

Our Monte Rosso Vineyard Cabernet Sauvignon is a slice of history in a glass. We gathered the fruit from a selection of our favorite blocks in our historic Monte Rosso Vineyard, including the oldest Cabernet Sauvignon block in California. The nose fills with Monte Rosso's signature spice and sweet wood aromatics and a thread of smoky ancho. Notes of ripe cherry, black currant, and warm plum compote fill the palate.

2018 Howell Mountain Cabernet Sauvignon

The 2018 vintage reveals a bouquet of traditional cabernet aromas awakened by undertones of forest floor, pine needle, and fragrant loam. The plush yet powerful palate showcases notes of black currant, elderberry, cocoa dusted truffle, and cedar. The long, textured finish leaves an enduring impression. This cabernet will reward those with enough patience to lay in their cellar for five to ten years.

2019 Stagecoach Vineyard Cabernet Sauvignon

Stagecoach Vineyard Cabernet Sauvignon brings the presence of nearly 1,800 feet elevation piercing through the fog and the unforgiving rocky terrain to this wine. A dense concentration of blueberry reduction and black currant from the longer ripening season rises from the glass. Notes of black mission fig and mocha dust are framed by crushed bay leaf and star anise. A buoyant, supple structure and youthful mouthfeel carries through to a lasting finish.

2018 Lot No. 1 Cabernet Sauvignon

The 2018 vintage is comprised of Cabernet Sauvignon from Stagecoach Vineyard, Mount Veeder, Atlas Peak, Howell Mountain, and other outstanding sites throughout Napa Valley AVA. From a growing perspective the 2018 vintage began like 2017, with plentiful winter rains. A consistently warm and steady summer eased into a mild fall, resulting in a slightly later harvest that delivered beautifully developed fruit with outstanding mountainside characteristics.
